Workshop Target Group

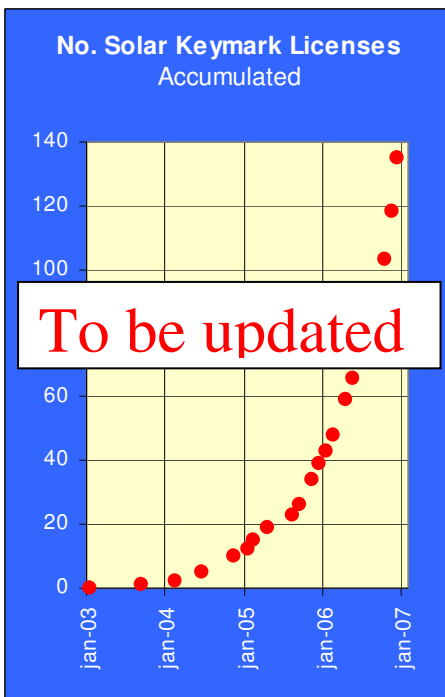
